<u>MISSION OF SECTION</u>: The Mobile Source Compliance and Outreach Section is responsible for implementation and outreach for strategies to reduce emissions from in-use heavy duty diesel mobile sources. These sources include trucks, regional and long-haul trucks, and other on-road mobile sources.

<u>CONCEPT OF POSITION</u>: Under close (Range A) or general (Range B or C) supervision of the manager of the Mobile Source Compliance and Outreach Section, the incumbent performs Air Pollution Specialist work at the Range A, B, or C level. The position is responsible for various tasks, typically related to medium- and heavy-duty mobile sources. These tasks may include outreach and education for fleets and other stakeholders, regulatory development, intra-agency coordination, and coordination with outside entities. This position may require up to 25% travel. The specific duties of the position are as follows:
