As a crucial member of the Modernization and Innovation Branch (MIB), the Cloud Network Architect is instrumental in aligning network strategies with the overarching goals of the organization. The position requires substantial collaboration with the Project Executive Workgroup (PEW) to ensure that Modernization projects adhere to strategic objectives and utilize the Hybrid Agile Framework (HAF) for efficient and effective project execution.					

The Cloud Network Architect works closely with fellow EDDNext Lead Domain Architects to ensure a cohesive approach to network solutions, aligning these with the California Department of Technology Project Approval Lifecycle standards. This position requires an expert understanding of network technologies and their integration into cloud-based environments, driving operational efficiencies and enhancing system availability across the department.
