PERCENTAGE OF TIME PERFORMING DUTIES	Essential Functions
35%	Performs commercial vehicle safety inspections in accordance with the procedures taught at the Commercial Enforcement Training Course. Determines if the vehicles and the operators comply with Federal and State laws, rules and regulations. Vehicle inspections include undercarriage inspection of the brakes, steering, frame and suspension. Other items inspected include (but are not limited to) lights, tires, wheels, connection devices, exhaust systems, safe loading, and hazardous materials shipments.
35%	Examines driver license qualifications, records of duty status, hours of service, and driver condition during the operator inspection portion. Observes and records all vehicle and driver information, defects, and violations on a computer-generated form and referred to a CHP Officer for enforcement action. Inspections may be performed at the Facility or on the roadside.
10%	Operates truck scale, detecting trucks in violation of size and weight laws. Refers violators to a CHP Officer for enforcement action. Selects trucks for inspections and directs them into inspection bays.
10%	Researches and interprets laws, rules, and regulations to assist drivers in obtaining compliance; answers questions and assists motorists.
5%	Cleans work stations, stocks supplies, manages work environment to ensure safe working conditions.
