<p>The Registered Nurse (RN) will meet the legal requirements to practice as a professional RN in California.</p> <p>Under general supervision of the Supervising Registered Nurse (SRN), the RN will be responsible for resident care duties in the Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) unit and may act as a lead in the absence of the shift lead. Duties include but are not limited to the following:</p>	
Percentage of time performing duties:	ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS
40%	<p>Make rounds and report any unusual resident conditions to physicians and the Supervising Registered Nurse without delay. Transcribe notes and physician's orders. Obtain medications from the Talyst Remote Dispensing Unit (RDU). Administer medications and treatments and update resident records. Assume responsibility for ensuring that consents, laboratory reports, and resident charts are completed. Complete incident reports as needed and submit them in a timely manner.</p>
25%	<p>Interview each resident upon admission and explain the role of the various staff members on the unit. Complete a nursing history and assessment; complete a physical assessment; document findings including skin assessment. Formulate a written plan of care for the resident identifying physical, emotional, and social needs. Orient new residents to the physical layout of the unit, specific unit routine, and the use of the call bell system. Assure that a physical inventory of the residents' belongings is completed and clothing and personal items are marked with the resident's name.</p>
25%	<p>Formulate a written nursing care plan for each resident in consultation with all unit nursing staff and the physician. Review plans weekly and as indicated by change in resident condition and complete weekly summaries as scheduled. Observe residents frequently; plan appropriate nursing care; and document pertinent information in nurses' notes. Identify rehabilitation potential of individual residents and plan care directed toward attaining optimum level of function as demonstrated by maintaining proper body positioning and body alignment of bedfast residents and maintaining adequate nutritional fluid intake.</p>
5%	<p>Assist in other units as need arises.</p> <p>Working overtime is a requirement of this position.</p>
