Pattern II & III

“... which must have included experience working in at least three of following areas: electrical, plumbing, heating water and power systems; and power systems; repairing various mechanical and automotive equipment, and performing minor building construction, repair and painting.”:

Experience in electrical repair work includes, but is not limited to:

- Electrical technology
- Electrical installations
- Maintaining electrical systems
- Repairing wiring systems
- Installing indoor and outdoor receptacles, lighting circuits and fixtures
- Troubleshooting and repairing electrical systems
- Installing fire alarm systems

Experience in plumbing, heating, water and power systems includes, but is not limited to:

- Inspect and repair standard plumbing installations
- Assemble pipe sections, tubing, or fittings
- Maintain water and sewage systems
- Modify pipe (e.g., measure cut, thread, bend)
- Inspect and repair HVAC equipment
- Troubleshoot and maintain building power systems
- Repair gas lines, water heaters, and other gas appliances
